I write with reference to the above proposed development at Stourton Grange South ref HG2-124

I have concerns that with the proposed development there will be a need for a new bypass road to Garforth. This itself would be a big cost and will there be any benefits to the local area from such a scheme.

Does this proposed development represent the best choice for Garforth. I believe the site is affected by mines, which could prevent any potential development.

I therefore do not consider that Stourton Grange Farm South represents the most suitable option for growth for Garforth.

An alternative site exists to the north of the railway line to the east of Garforth – Sturton Grange North. This site does not have the impediments of Stourton Grange Farm South and is a more suitable site. I request that the Council consider this site as a more appropriate and sound option for this part of the District.

I Believe the need for new Sporting Facilities in the area is vital and with the development and growth of "Leeds Ladies "Football club, who currently share Garforth town's Pitch, it would be a great step in the right direction for the club, if they were to have their own Training Facilities and Stadium on the more appropriate site "Stourton Grange North.

I urge the Council to remove the Stourton Grange South site from the SAP and instead include the proposed Stourton Grange North site.
