The size of this proposal is entirely out of reasonable scale when it is going to increase the population of the village by 25 % at a stroke. The services, health and education and retail would be completely swamped and unable to cope causing serious problems. I have not seen anything to show that these problems have been addressed.. .Bramhope will cease to be a village with its own identity and simply become an addition to the sprawling conurbations to the North of Leeds.

This proposal is requiring removal of the Green belt status of the land. I understand that government guidance is that this should only occur in exceptional circumstances when all Brown field sites have exhausted.I understand that is not the case in Leeds. Green belt must be protected for the health of our nation.

The A660 artery into Leeds is already choked with serious delays particularly at Lawnswood and Headingly. This proposal would simply add to these difficulty with its attendant costs to society.
