I refer to the above plans to build 155 houses on the above site and I object to the proposed development for a number of reasons:

The traffic on the A65 into Leeds is a nightmare already, especially at rush hour and more houses around the A65 will only make this worse. I make the journey into Leeds daily and more often than not the traffic is at a standstill.

The schools in the local area are already at capacity and will not be able to cope.

There have already been a number of housing developments in recent months in the surrounding area and there cannot possibly be a need for more houses in this area. Surely there are better urban sites within Leeds that could be developed, leaving this as green land.

There are lots of mature and rare trees on this site which are home to bats, owls and other birds.

This site was defended as greenbelt land in the early 1990's and Historic England consider that this area should actually be part of the conservation area it is adjacent to.

In my opinion these are more than enough reasons for this development NOT to proceed.
