Message : I am writing to express my concerns about the building development that has been proposed on Banksfield site (ref. 1255b 1255a) in Yeadon. The area is already congested with traffic, I feel that the roads cannot cope as it is. There is one through road in&out of the estate (Coppice Wood Avenue) which is already difficult to get through. Cars park on one side of the road so there is only one lane for traffic to drive through, every time I drive down it you have to reverse to let the cars coming in the opposite direction pass which will only worsen with more houses. This is a hazard especially as children often play along this road. The proposed development will increase traffic which is putting children's lives at risk, especially as there is a school in the middle of the estate. Green spaces are important to us - we meet many dog walkers who use this area too. I am concerned that there's becoming fewer green sites available for leisure especially when there's brown sites available to build on.
