I write to express my concern and formally object to the development of sites hg2-41, hg2-42 and hg2-43 and all other sites impacting the Rawdon / Yeadon area under the Leeds site allocation plan public consultation process.

It is my understanding that the proposed development is not in line with national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).
