I object to in the inclusion of site HG2 41 in the Site Allocations Plan as the site is green belt. Removing the site from the green belt is contrary to National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) Section 9, paragraph 80 because including the site for development fails the 5 tests of green belt purpose. The inclusion of the site to achieve housing number target is not an exceptional circumstance as per paragraph 83 of NPPF. Based on this I do not think that the Plan is sound as it is not consistent with national policy.

I also object to the allocation of housing in other green field sites that will detrimentally impact our local community. These sites are:

HG2-43 (5009) - conservation area at Park Lane College

HG2-42 Fields at Broadway and Calvery Lane

HG2-12 - Fields at Woodlands Drive

I think it will be terrible, now and for future generations, to lose such beautiful precious countryside.

My main objections are:

- we will lose a beautiful countryside that is enjoyed by the community and a habitat for wildlife. I have seen deer, hedgehogs and many other rare animals,
- there will be far more traffic congestion and pollution. The A65 and the roundabout are already heavily congested
- the roundabout there just will not be able to accommodate another 1000+ homes that our planned
- its creates urban sprawl and loss of community as Horsforth and Rawdon just merge into one urban area with lost surrounding countryside and demarcation
