I am writing to object to proposed developments in and around Rawdon that will destroy both beautiful green belt as well as the village nature of the area.

Site HG2-41 is of particular concern. The roads cannot cope with the existing houses in the area - the a65 is already gridlocked by 7am each morning and again by 4.30pm in the afternoon. With 770 houses and a new school this will have a very negative impact for those living in Rawdon itself - making access impossible at certain times of the day.

The proposed HG2-41 development will also destroy beautiful greenbelt, wildlife habitats and the view over the valley. The site is close to and so will impact significantly on a conservation area. Linked to this this conservation area will be seriously impacted by the HG3-3 development.

These developments and others including HG2-12, HG3-2, HG3-3 and HG3-4 if developed will merge Horsforth and Rawdon into one creating urban sprawl and destroying the distinctive village nature of Rawdon itself.
