Good Morning councillors I would like to express my concerns regarding the latest City plan for the large scale developments in the Outer South area of the City and feel that the number of proposed developments across the 3 phases is too high in such a small area, with very little done to address the increased pressure on the already over stretched infrastructure.

I was a keen supporter of the tram development a few years back and very much looked forward to a service to link the outer area with the City centre as a Leeds tax payer I feel we are left very much out on a limb and transport for the elderly and those who do not drive is shocking in the area, with many services operating only a 1 an hour service.

I am not one that easily puts an email together as I believe as a City we need to all accept that housing needs to be developed across the City in order for us to grow and retain a vibrant workforce etc. However the sites proposed are far too big and on greenbelt areas. I note that one future development could be that of Tingley Station, now I would have thought that the site there which was a small holding with its old derelict house and railway buildings as well as access on to the dual carriageway would have been a far more realistic and amenable development for the area, rather than those suggested for Westerton Road, Haigh Wood x 2 and Thorpe Lane, This one development would take the full allocation of the proposed units on the other sites over 1000.

I would welcome your thoughts on this and your position when it comes to the approval of the City Plan
