First of all I would like to know if there was an engineer's report recommendation completed when they tried to help congestion on the ringroad ie Horsforth roundabout. If so, could I see this report. This has made travelling on the A65 so much worse for commuters crossing the ringroad ie Rawdon to Horsforth and vice versa. Officials must (or just check the speed cameras as evidence) check and chart the volume of cars queuing from Rawdon crossroads - to Horsforth roundabout.
