I would like to argue against building houses and a school on Church Lane opposite the historic, Grade 1 listed, Adel Church. The council not only has a duty to the present but also to the future. Once built on this site can never revert to what it is now - a beautiful and historic site looking out over neighbouring fields - a view untouched for centuries. I implore you to think again before desecrating this site with modern housing by a 12th century Norman church.
