I would like to register my objections against the proposed housing developments in Bramhope.

I do not agree with any of the proposed housing sites in Bramhope:

HG2 - 15 (3400)  
HG2 - 16 (1002)  
HG2 - 17 (1080\_3367A)

My comments apply to all of the above sites:

A)Developing these sites will lead to a disproportionate increase in a village classified as a smaller settlement.

B)There is a lack of up to date demographic evidence to support such proposals.

C) It would lead to an unacceptable loss of the green belt and green fields

D)It would have significant detrimental effects on the local ecology, landscape and the Conservation area.

E) There is a lack of local infrastructure to cope with such an increase.

F) The inability of the A660 corridor to cope with this scale of development must be considered.

I also wish my comments to be applied to previously consulted sites:

1181A,1181B,1204, 3434, 3367B

I also wish to add that these sites should remain in the green belt, highway accessibility is poor and development would cause urban sprawl.

I strongly believe that all brownfield sites in Leeds need to be exhausted before any consideration is given to development on greenfield sites. It is imperative that the current demands on infrastructure need to be examined before any site is approved, the local school is always oversubscribed, Otley road is already extremely congested and the local health centre really could not cope with the proposed level of development.

Bramhope is a lovely village and it would be such a shame to lose the sense of community felt by those living in this area. Developments of this size are entirely inappropriate and would spoil the feel of this historic village.
