I live just Off Old Pool Bank and would like to lodge a strongly felt disagreement with the plans suggested for the farm land close to the Shell Garage in Pool in the first instance. The land should be kept for producing produce thereby reducing the economical and ecological damage incurred by sending food long distances. Moreover farm land, where appropriate, allows for wild animals and plants protecting our natural habitats for the benefit of both ourselves and the planet as a whole. Further to this is can be used for leisure purposes which are a significant factor in this area as testified by the recent Tour de France and the multitude of climbers etc in the area. On a more pragmatic level, the road systems, flood protection, School system, medical provision and the community of Pool will not be able to cope with a large influx of people who can only be transient without significant changes to the aforementioned infrastructure.

This combined by an increasing population via proposed plans in Otley will change the area beyond its abilities to cope. Anyone travelling by private or public transport is deeply affected by the current poor infrastructure and crowded road systems. Yorkshire life is not improving, traditions and communities are being swamped.

As an incomer who chose thus area for what it represented, it deeply upsets me that plans are being pushed forward without sufficient care for people and the environment.
