I would like to object to the proposed planning application, Site HG2-10 (1221) Gill Lane.

For the following reasons;

This development is going to severely erode greenbelt area.

The Gusieley, Yeadon, Rawdon - infrastructure can not handle the current demands never mind an additional 155 houses.

Traffic is horrendous and this is not being addressed the creation of an additional 155 homes only adds to this problem. The traffic survey conducted by the developer was done during Half term this doesn't accurately represent the usual traffic.

Local schools are already oversubscribed and struggling.

We have been unable to find a local dentists since moving to the area as they are all full.

The site will disrupt the local nature - losing several beautiful mature trees and adversely affecting the wildlife that utilises this area, Owls, Woodpeckers and Bats.
