Objection to the Site Allocation Plans. - building on green belt land

As a resident of Horsforth I wish to object most strongly regarding the plans to build on the following sites:-

HG2-41 (4240), HG2-42 (1016), H2-43 (5009) and HG2-12 (4254)

My main reasons of objection are that NPPF states green belt should be protected. I believe that brownfield sites should be utilised first. There are many brownfield sites that should be used before these important sites are ruined forever. Affordable housing will not be sufficient on these sites to fulfil the need for this type of housing.

There is a lack of infrastructure to support the building of this large number of houses, we already have a very large development at Kirkstall Forge going ahead. There is insufficient healthcare provision or indeed education provision. Although some is planned this will not be in time to support the current need. The A65 is already a problem for traffic flow ahead of this current development and the one on The Clariant site. Further traffic should Not be added.

The natural environment is of health benefit to everyone- from the views to the benefit of fresh air and just being able to walk unhindered by housing. Please don't take these benefits away from us - they are vital.
