Dear Sir, I would like to register my objection to the proposal that 25 houses be built on the Church Lane Paddock Meanwood. As a resident of Holmwood Avenue (number 15 LS 64NH), I feel that it is totally inappropriate that more houses should be built in this particular spot. Firstly it would make traffic problems insurmountable and extremely dangerous. Both exits to Meanwood Road/ Stonegate road are already totally congested and dangerous and the increase traffic would be a danger to pedestrians in particular children. Secondly, the field is at the level of the water table and several springs cause problems with flooding which if diverted will only move the problem elsewhere such as Meanwood Park and Beck. Thirdly there had been already a huge amount of building of new houses in Meanwood on the Woodleas and elsewhere and more planned for the hospital and Working Men's Club so Meanwood has already contributed enormously to the planning agenda. And finally this is historically and emotionally of great importance to the local people. The setting of the beautiful protected area Meanwood C of E Church would be totally spoiled and the local residents would be deprived of an area of calm and beauty and nature essential to their emotional and physical wellbeing.
