We feel so sad and devastated to hear that yet another Greenbelt area along the A65 near Nether Yeadon, Guiseley and Henshaw, is wanted to be used for 155 houses in Gill Lane Fields, what devastation to such a beautiful area. How many more sites are to be proposed in Aireborough? surely this area has had enough new houses within the last few years.

Having lived in Horsforth and Guiseley for over 43 years we seen the Boundaries between Leeds/Kirkstall/Horsforth/Rawdon/Yeadon/ Guiseley/Menston/Burley-in-Wharfedale and Ilkley become closer and closer and will soon cease to exist. The traffic just gets worse and worse, no new schools have been built, only 2 replacement schools at Yeadon and Rawdon, and an extension at Guiseley Church School, which does very little to ease the situation.

The Doctor and Dentist surgeries are so full that it takes at least 2 weeks for an appointment with one's own Doctor.

The A65 is only a single carriageway through the main part of this area. Green Lane traffic is horrendous, the only way for heavy goods vehicle to get to the Airport from the A65 and Apperley Lane.

We long to see undisturbed Green areas where trees that have grown there for many years, and the habitats of birds, and wonderful views of the Moors and Chevin.
