Dear Sir/Madam,

I object in the strongest terms to the proposed allocation of land off Weetwood Avenue for housing in the Leeds Site Allocations Plan.

The proposal fails the tests of soundness in terms of consistency with National Planning Policy and justification.

The fields are in a conservation area and should have enhanced protection from development.

The fields are a Greenfield site designated for recreational activities and provide habitat for wildlife and space for people to exercise, if they are developed then these amenities will be lost.

It is not necessary to meet demand for housing by building on this site. The greatest demand is for social housing which this development will not meet. There are many suitable alternative sites for development which do not pose the same risk to the environment.
