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I would like to object to the proposed plans to increase the size of Bramhope by more than 25%, especially the on site references HG2- 16(1002) and HG2-17(1080-3367A).

HG2-16(1002) - Creskeld Lane, Bramhope

Road access is insufficient and wouldn't be able to cope with approx 50 more cars, especially with Creskeld Lane being very narrow and winding. It would also lead to more traffic coming on to the A660. Building on the land is also an unacceptable loss of green belt land.

HG2-17(1080-3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope

There would also be an unacceptable loss of green belt land with the amount of houses planned.

The village would turn into a small town and wouldn't be able to cope as it doesn't have the amenities or the infrastructure to deal with such a large increase in population.

The local doctors is already very busy and you have to wait for appointments and this would only increase if the housing application went through.

The A660 is already very busy and this would be made worse.
