As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites:

HG2-41 HG2-42 HG2-43 HG2-46

HG2-10 HG2-12 HG2-9 HG2-54 HG2-5 HG2-3 HG2-3 HG2-2 HG2-2 HG2-4

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and greenfields.

The fields and open green spaces, which are being proposed for development, are important to me because they provide a pleasant and natural environment which my family can enjoy through exercise and outdoor activities.

Further building will destroy yet more wildlife and beautiful landscapes.

Also the areas around me suffer with huge volumes of traffic which would be compounded with more housing and more people.

These sites should continue to be part of Leeds' 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate.

Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own.

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
