I am writing concerning proposed development on green belt land at Horsforth & Rawdon

The proposal is not consistent with national policy

Where will the children from these developments go to school, the local schools are already oversubscribed.

The roads can barely cope with the amount of traffic already using them, with long tailbacks & queues already happening I dread to think of how bad the traffic would be, with hundreds more cars trying to join them every morning & evening.
