As a local resident I object on the basis that proposals for development in these locations contravene the NPPF. These sites at present form an effective buffer to stop Leeds and Horsforth development merging into existing development in Rodley, Calverley, Rawden and Guiseley. If this were allowed to happen then we fear that these settlements would all be swallowed into the major urban area and lose their distint character. My family is concerned that development on these sites would undermine the open nature of the Green Belt and be of detriment to the character of the local area. We would urge the Planning department and Council members to review opportunities to meet housing need on brownfield rather than Green Belt sites.

We also are concerned about the impact of additional traffic congestion on an already highly congested A65.
