Dear Leeds City Council

I am writing to object to the proposed new housing site HG2 - 17 (1080 & 3367A) in Bramhope.

376 new houses on this site will be extremely detrimental to the village of Bramhope for the following reasons:-

- * this will increase the village size to create an urban sprawl with no supporting centre of facilities such as shops,
- * the extra resulting commuter traffic will put an unacceptable strain on already congested roads including the A660, Kings Road and the back roads to Arthington and Moor Allerton,
- * public transport through Bramhope is already inadequate with just one unreliable and at times infrequent bus service and 376 extra households will put even more pressure on this service,
- * the one primary school will not cope with any extra child numbers and the health centre will struggle to cope with the extra population,
- * the land proposed to be built on is greenbelt and should remain as this for the sake of future generations, the environment including the air that we breathe and the declining wildlife of the area.

I sincerely hope that you will reconsider using this precious resource for new housing and instead look at brownfield sites and areas that are already urbanised and able to cope with an increase in population and traffic.
