The proposal to build nearly 800 houses at HG2-41 seems ridiculous when the Council as well as residents have often mentioned the congestion on the A65 so why would you propose to make it much worse by adding to the problem? The land is currently enjoyed by families walking their dogs, picking stawberries and generally enjoying the green space that is still left in the built up areas of Leeds. There must be more suitable sites for a large scale housing development. The number of houses proposed for the areas of Rawdon and Horsforth are disproportionately high for the size of the suburbs and will have an enormous negative impact on the areas and the residents enjoyment of the area they live in.
