As a local resident, I am writing to object to the plan to develop the site at Church Lane Paddock, Meanwood, ref. HG2-50. I am objecting because of issues around traffic safety and increased congestion, the overstretching of amenities such as schools, doctors and dentists, increased flood risks and the impact on wildlife and the landscape as a whole – particularly in regards to being beside the Grade II Listed Holy Trinity Church.

The paddock is the last remnant of open space in the village area of Meanwood that has not been the subject of infill and built on. Although we have Meanwood Park, this is of a very different character and Meanwood Park is not accessible to everyone, including some older residents who still walk to the shops past the paddock.
