I would like to object very strongly to the current plans to increasing the size of Bramhope village by more than 25%, in particular to the site references HG2 - 16 (1002) and HG2-17 (1080-3367A).

HG2-16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope

Building on the land in this area would lead to an unacceptable loss of green belt land, and cause excessive traffic on a quiet, narrow lane. Road access to the area is insufficient.

HG2-17 (1080-3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope

The extremely large number of houses planned for this area would also lead to an unacceptable loss of green belt.

The infrastructure of the village (such as medical facilities) cannot cope with such a large increase in housing in this area.

Bramhope village would in effect be more like a small town.

The A660 is already very busy, and a substantial increase in local traffic would add to existing issues of noise pollution.

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
