### Leeds City Council Housing Plan - Site Allocation Plan

I would like to comment on the identification of Site HG2-37 (Brownberrie Lane, Horsforth) for housing development.

The proposal does not have my support for reasons as follows:

- 1) Housing infill on this site contradicts existing LCC policy to protect 'greenfield' space. The policy is important - further erosion of it will lead ultimately to the merger of the city of Leeds with Bradford, resulting in one giant conurbation, with resultant loss of identity for Horsforth specifically and Leeds generally.
- 2) Preserving pockets of green land is necessary and vital for rain absorption. The stretch of road on Brownberrie Lane directly adjacent to Site HG2-37 is seriously affected by poor drainage at present. Building on the proposed site would exacerbate a problem which is already a danger to motorists.
