To Whom It May Concern,

As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites:

HG2-12, HG2-41, HG2-42, HG2-43, HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4, HG2-44, HG2-45, HG2-46

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are not consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and greenfields.

I consider the fields and open green spaces, which are being proposed for development as particularly important to the local amenity of the area and are frequently used by my family and many other numerous local residents, particularly the areas around HG2-41, HG2-42 and HG2-43, and I have great concerns about the effect these plans would have on the wildlife that inhabit these areas.

These sites should continue to be part of Leeds' 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are not consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. There is already an increasing issue with volume of traffic on local roads, places at schools, availability of appointments at doctors surgeries, etc. which will no doubt soon be exacerbated by the new developments in the area which have already gained planning permission. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
