I must again protest at the proposed developments in Bramhope. We are a village in a green belt area. The local roads do not lend themselves to further increases in traffic. The main road is choked at peak times and a nightmare to cross by vehicle or on foot.

People would need jobs & make the queues to Leeds even worse, & the Dyneley junction would be even more congested. The local school is full & children are being "bussed" all over.

Breary Lane East would ruin the approach to the village, causing urban sprawl, & virtually connect directly to Leeds.

Moor Road has nothing to commend it either, should stay as pure countryside.

There must be many more suitable sites nearer to Leeds centre, with all the facilities much more to hand.
