My objections to the plans are as follows:

Development on greenbelt land may only be used for housing in exceptional circumstances – ie not the desire to meet housing targets.

These are housing targets which are out of date and overinflated. More realistic figures have been suggested by the Office of National Statistics.

This site would not provide affordable housing but would simply be more lucrative for developers.

Brownfield sites across Leeds have not been exhausted – sites which would provide affordable housing.
