I am writing to object to the proposed developments in and around Rawdon , Leeds with particular reference to sites HG2-12 and HG2-41.

As a 39 year old woman who was brought up in Rawdon and is now bringing up my own 3 children in this area I am saddened to think how the proposal and number of planned houses will affect me, my children, their future and the community here in Rawdon as a whole. I am not against building new houses and I agree that more need to be built however these sites are not suitable for this level of housing and I believe there are many suitable brown field sites in the area that should be utilised first.

The infrastructure in these areas will not be able to cope with the demands. The already oversubscribed schools and doctors and especially the already horrendous congestion on the roads surrounding these areas will be a disaster for local residence. Parking is already an issue in certain areas at certain times and 1 mile drives can already take in excess of 20 minutes.

The precious greenbelt will be destroyed not only spoiling the views and character of the area but destroying habitats, farmland and restricting leisure activities for the residents, running, cycling and walking. Not to mention the issues we have already had in the last day or two with flooding in the area which additional housing will only make worse.

I was also unaware of the public consultation held by the council in 2013 which I believe I should have been informed about.

One of the best things about living in this area is the amount of open space available and the varied and interesting wildlife that can be seen including red kites often spotted circling in the skies and I would hate to see it disappear by an ineffective, not legally compliant and unjustified development.
