To whom it may concern,

I am writing to tell you not to build on greenbelt land around the city.
I am particularly concerned about the following sites:

HG2-41 Fields south of A65 (Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium).
HG-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus.
HG-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon
HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 Fields off A65, Rawdon.

I believe that greenbelt land should not be built on because this is not consistent with the national policy.

I do not think that you are justified in using greenbelt land before utilising Brownfield sites.
I firmly believe that your proposal goes against Leeds City Council's Leeds Core Strategy.

These areas are important to me and my family as we use them for walks together, having a green space to cycle through, and having a green area to explore with the children. Keeping them healthy and nurturing an interest in their own local environment, in nature and setting an example to keep healthy wherever they can (even if they live in a city).

The greenbelt also provides respite from the continual built up nature alongside the A65 which will in turn keep a check on the volume of traffic on this, already beyond saturated, route.
