RE: LEEDS SITE ALLOCATION PLANS - FORMAL OBJECTION

Dear Sir / Madam,

As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites:

HG2-41 - South of A65 from Horsforth & Rawdon RA to crematorium
HG2-42 - Broadway and Calverley Lane, Horsforth
HG2-43 - Horsforth Campus
HG2-46 - Horsforth (former waste water treatment work)

The above sites are not in line with national policy as they are Green Belt sites (except for part of HG2-43 and HG2-46). This green land must be protected. Otherwise, Horsforth and its surrounding area will become an urban sprawl with no green spaces.

These developments would be environmentally detrimental to wildlife and also increase the likelihood of flooding in the area, which, as a resident of lower Newlay, is of great concern to me.

We also don't have the infrastructure in place to support all this new development, particularly with regards to traffic volume which is already problematic. Coupled with other developments going ahead such as Kirkstall Forge there will be huge pressure on the infrastructure - especially traffic volumes on the A65.

Leeds should maintain these sites as part of its 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' within the Adopted Core Strategy.

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
