The purpose of this communication is to register our profound concerns with regard to the **Leeds Site Allocation Plan Section HG-2-1 (3026) New Birks Farm Ings Lane Guiseley**.

We **strongly oppose** any building development plans that would impact on any land that is presently recognised as Green Belt land.

This position is in keeping with the governments national policy on protecting Green Belt land.

We consider it necessary to maintain sufficient buffer areas between established communities and that further encroachments would be detrimental to all concerned, putting an intolerable strain on already overloaded facilities.

We are not opposed to the appropriate recycling use of brownfield sites.

Any further redevelopment within the Guiseley/Menston district would require considerable traffic management inspection with drastic implications, the A65 in particular.
