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**Dear Sirs**

I wish to object in the strongest way to the proposal to change the 'Green Space' designation of the site between Weetwood Court/Walk and Otley Road – HG2-48 In order to build houses.

As a resident of Weetwood Court I consider this to be an unnecessary and detrimental consideration for the area and its residents and would ask you to re-consider.

I object to the proposed change in site designation. I was under the impression that Leeds City Council considered green spaces important and would not be considered for additional housing.

I realise this is a pre-application but I sincerely hope it will be rejected as unacceptable if it becomes an application.

A major objection is the access arrangement for cars and other traffic needing to access the new development of course during construction which according to plans I have been shown would need to come through Weetwood Manor into Weetwood Court though this wasn't particularly clear. We already have issues around traffic on Weetwood Lane coming down from the Ring Road. Cars leaving Weetwood Court continue to have issues trying to exit onto Weetwood Lane.

Such a development would mean additional traffic, pollution and noise and potentially an increased hazard. It would also mean a potential loss of an area which does support wild life including deer and red kite. I am sure there are many other objections to the use of that particular site related more to the site itself which I am not qualified to comment on.

I ask you to please throw out any application for this development as it will have a major negative effect on the environment and the quality of life for local residents and visitors.
