Re comments on the consultation for Horsforth,

The Hg 2-41 site was not previously available for consultation indeed it was not added until early January 2015. No one was aware that it was a part of the site allocation, and had not been subject to consultation.

2. Indeed this site is green belt and its addition to site allocations in meeting housing targets is against Nppf. Once it is used for housing it would not return to green belt status.

The target of 777 houses plus a large school must create density of traffic in a congested road system. In fact there is an educational establishment site. HG2-43.

The HG2-43 site is currently an educational site. Keeping it for education instead of residential use will meet the need for educational sites in the area. It is noted the use of this site for residential development has not been opened for consultation until now.

Site Hg2-42 is a green field site no consultation has been until now, so is not legal. The total effect of the proposed site allocations in Horsforth of over 2000 houses and the 2300 plus in Aireborough, 1000 in Kirkstall Forge and the additional housing in Cookridge, West Park, must severely test an already stretched infrastructure of the area.
