Dear Mr Crapper, thank you for your representation.

In answer to your question, no, the representations are not available to view at this time. At submission/examination stage paper copies of all of the representations will need to be available (a set for the Planning Inspectorate, the Programme Officer and Leeds City Council). In the meantime, representations received will be publically available once we have had an opportunity to process the representations. However, given the number and complexities of the representations received (and which we will continue to receive until the 16th November), this processing will take some time, and at present it is not possible to set out a timescale for when they will be made publically available. When they are made available, physical copies will be available to view at the Leonardo Building. At present we haven't arrived at a view as to whether this material will be available to view on-line.
