#### 3.3. Please set out why you think the Plan is sound?

#### Ecology/Landscape/Tree(s)

This site is within the Guiseley Conservation Area, which is being destroyed. A green habitat to many species, the wild life flora and fauna needs to be protected. Several rights of way should be protected for future generations.

#### Loss of Greenbelt

There has been too much loss of Greenbelt land in this area already due to overdevelopment. Urban sprawl is removing the last place of green belt in Guiseley

#### Local Services / Facilities

Local services are already stretched beyond capacity without further development. Insufficient local employment facilities

#### Highways / Transport

The existing infrastucture is already totally inadequate to cope with additional traffic. Park Road and the A65 are the most congested roads in Guiseley. Both gridlocked at various

times of the day.

Exit on to Park Road from both Coach Road and Silverdale Avenue is dangerous due to road network

Bus services are inadequate, and are unreliable due to gridlocked roads. The trains are overcrowded at peak times.

#### Schools

This area is not suitable for a school due to the dangerous access from and exit to Park Road. Waiting parked vehicles would also be problematic.
