Where 777 homes, would add to the already overworked infrastructure in that area. Rawdon would lose its identity it would become part of Horsforth. The A65 is already a nightmare of slow traffic all the way from Menston through Guiseley into Leeds. As a Rawdon Resident if we go to Ilkley we go down Pool Bank and bypass Guiseley. If we go to Leeds we avoid Horsforth roundabout and use the Brownberry Lane route. Past the Trinity College University at Horsforth This is now as slow as the A 65. On a very narrow Road The whole idea should be to keep the villages separate from the sprawl of the city their character and appeal are being threatened by Planning that seems to be oblivious of these essentials.. Guiseley has been decimated by indiscriminate planning by Leeds City Council who appear to be increasing the rates they acquire at the expense of all the local community.

We object to anything on a Greenfield site. Our predecessor fought for those sites to be kept for future generations Altering the wording such as "core strategy " Strategic Green Infrastructure, Special Landscape, to bend the rules, cannot get away from the basic principle. They are permanent and Councillors of all types, who are here for a relatively short while, should accept this fact.
