I am writing to you regarding your proposed site allocations in the Horforth, Rawdon area.

I have lived in Horforth for 45 years and have seen the many in-fill developments and large developments e.g. The Plymouth Brethren's on a greenfield site many years ago. It seems that you intend to build further on this site.

There are many other incursions onto greenfield areas in your proposals

I believe these are contrary to the
NPPF - Haverhill will lose its
discrete boundaries which prevent urban
sprawl eg. between Leeds & Bradford

It will also spoil the old, mill-stone
grit character, one of Haverhill's assets.
There will also be loss of country side
e.g. Haverhill Roundabout to Rawdon
Crematorium. Apart from the use of
the waste water treatment works, I don't
think your plans do anything to assist
in urban regeneration or recycle derelict land
which is part of the National Plan
Policy Framework

I have never credited ^{the need} your target of
70,000 houses and thus am sure your
plans need to be consistent with national
policy
