### HOUSING SITES IN BRAMHOPE

I have looked at the proposed plans for building 441 houses in Bramhope. I think that such development would be very unwise. Bramhope is a small village with over-used facilities such as small shops in a narrow street that are difficult to use. People have to use a busy A660 Road which is difficult to get on to. Most people commute from Bramhope since there are few employment areas in Bramhope. There is only one infrequent bus service available. It would be easy to conclude that Bramhope is really too large at the moment.

The addition of the proposed large number of houses would make all the present facilities in the village much more difficult to use and create very difficult traffic problems leading to very awkward living conditions. The single lane roads would be very frustrating, particularly at school opening and closing times and at weekends.

The current plans merely to put houses in the village are short sighted. The overall effect of the requirements of an additional 1000+ residents needs to be considered and if that is done Bramhope expansion will be seen to be unwise.
