I wish to make an objection to the above proposals by Leeds City Council to build dwelling houses on the above areas of GREEN BELT land. This proposal is not consistent with the national policy, as I understand it. Travelling along the A65 into Leeds within the Ring Road several brown field large sites are clearly available for development so why ruin this environment for future generations to enjoy.

Having lived on the edge of the green belt for the past thirty years I know first hand the benefit this has on my community. We all enjoy the walks, children learn by seeing nature and exploring the woods and fields. We should not deprive future generations of this and all live in urban sprawl with no demarcation between one village and another, or worse, between one town and another.
