Re Site allocation to Rawdon etc

I was under the impression that "Green Belt" meant that it was land that was officially designated as such and preserved from Urban Development.

Over the last 10 or 20 years Ryeborough has seen an awful lot of housing particularly in Guiseley. What I would like to know is where are all the schools etc, the Doctors in the area, are already feeling the pressure, as they cope with an increasing work load.

Out of all the 1640 houses that are proposed for the area, only 7 are on a brownfield site. Why is this?

The A65 is already the "Road from Hell" and even more traffic is hardly likely to help. By building on Site 1642-41, some 777 houses, so roughly another 1500 cars. Also this site will join Rawdon to Horsforth, something which is totally unacceptable.

Surely the way forward is to look at "Brownfield Sites", that could be used in the first place.

As regards 1642A, the building of 102 homes along side to A658 near the Leeds/Bradford Airport. Who wants to live so close to

to the flight path?
