I strongly object to the proposed development of these sites. All of these sites are in Green Belt, according to the Leeds Core Strategy. They would destroy what little Green Belt there is along the A.65. It seems that Leeds City Council would like to have one massive housing development stretching from Kirkstall almost to the Bradford boundary. The traffic on the A65 would be increased tremendously.

Horsforth and Rawdon would be merged. This is against the National Planning Policy Framework.

At present, it is possible to look across green land to the Aire Valley & up towards Bradford. This would be lost. It would all become one massive urban sprawl.

There are still brown field sites in Leeds and other sites with Planning Permission, waiting to be developed. It is better to use these.
