Dear Sirs,

I am writing with my objection and grave concern with the proposed site allocation plan on the Greenfields between Gill Lane/Greenlea Avenue, on the A65 Yeadon. I have lived all my life in this area and while I understand that there is a need for more houses overall, this particular area of a two mile stretch, is in my opinion oversubscribed.

The traffic on the A65 is already over capacity, and at certain times of the day is almost unusable for the people living in the area, we have to work out alternative routes using the bye roads, which is causing congestions in other areas. The A65 is never resurfaced thoroughly, only the pot holes being filled.

As well as all the new houses already in the area we have two retail parks on the A65 at Guiseley, which attracts extreme, appalling traffic levels particularly at weekends.

I am led to believe that the schools are at capacity levels, and also the doctors' surgeries and dentists.

All the new houses built in the area so far are built purely for profit, very expensive, the number of starter homes and houses for the elderly you could count on your fingers.

Our young adults are being out priced of the area due to the vast increase of strangers moving in to over priced new homes. We are in danger of losing all of our young people from the area in which they were brought up.
