(2) HQ2-43 - Fields at Horsforth College

It is very concerning that over 900 homes could be built on the above two sites in Horsforth.

The A65 and the road from Roodley roundabout to the Horsforth roundabout are very often not roads but 'car parks' as the volume of traffic in this area is so high. For commuters it is a nightmare! We are not yet feeling the effects fully of the Clarendon site which is under development at the moment. This should never have been given planning permission.

If the Horsforth college is not continuing to be used - it would make a good school. Present schools are overflowing as are doctors and dentists surgeries.

These proposals to use Green Belt sites in the Local Plan are not consistent with the national policy.

The areas are full of wildlife and very important to us and other families for walking and exercising dogs. It would be a great shame if they were not available for future generations to enjoy. We need these 'green' areas to escape the noise and stress of the A65.
