Dear Sir / Madam,

I want to tell you that I am very sad that you want to build on the greenbelt and green field sites:

HG2-41 (4240) - Fields South of A65 from Horsforth & Rawdon RA to crematorium (including the strawberry fields

HG2-42 (1016) - Fields at Broadway and Calverley Lane, Horsforth

HG2-43 (5009) – Conservation area at Park Lane College Campus, Horsforth

HG2-12(4254) – Fields at Woodland's Drive

I live near this place and I think that if people build there it will change my life. So, these places should not be in the building plans. This is why I think that:

1. Inconsistent with National Planning Policy Framework:
 - I. INADEQUATE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSTRAINT: The plans say that special greenbelt land will be built on and this is not good. The green places need to be looked after.

- II. NON-EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCE: There is not a special reason why the houses have to be built in these places.
 - III. PRIORITISATION OF GREENEBLT OVER BROWN FIELD: The brown fields should be used first, before you build on the green ones.
 - IV. LOSS OF COMMUNITY IDENTITY: If new houses are built in these places, my home will be different. I live in Horsforth. With the new houses you won't be able to see Horsforth. All the places (like Rodley) will get squashed into one place.
 - V. LACK OF INFRASTRUCTRE: I think that there will be a big problem with schools and dentists and doctors and shops and high schools. We don't have lots in Horsforth. So it will be really bad when more houses are built. I might not have a high school to go to. Primary schools in Horsforth are getting really big and we don't want bigger ones.
2. Inconsistent with Leeds Development Plan Policies:
- I. LACK OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING: The new houses will be too much money for poor people. At school we have been learning about poor people and they need houses to live in.
 - II. DENIAL OF HOUSING TARGET RE-ASSEMENT NEED: Mummy says that we don't need all the houses that the council says that we do. She says the ideas are too old and that they need to look at the new targets.
 - III. DELAYING OF HOUSING TARGET RE-ASSEMENT NEED: People need to talk about the targets and not do any new houses.
3. Negative Impact on Highway Safety and Traffic:
- I. COMPROMISING ON SAFETY: Daddy goes to work on a bike. He says the roundabout is very dangerous and that there are too many cars. Mummy gets cross with Daddy because he gets to work quickly and she gets stuck in lots of traffic in the car. She says it's dangerous too.
 - II. INABILITY TO COPE WITH TRAFFIC: There are small bridges by these places, so it is not easy to get to them. There are not big enough roads to get to new houses.
4. Lack of Conservation of the Natural Environment:

- I. DESTRUCTION OF HABITATS: There are very special animals that live in the places. Things like newts, bats, owls, hawks, wild deer, and badgers. New houses will kill these animals.
 - II. ISOLATION OF WILDLIFE: The animals need lots of fields to be in. New houses will take away their homes and they won't be able to go on holiday.
 - III. REMOVAL OF COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT WITH COUNTRYSIDE: My friends like picking strawberries and raspberries in the summer and looking at the butterflies. I don't want them to die with the new houses.
5. Negative Effect on the Landscape:
- I. DESTRUCTION OF NATURAL VIEWS: I like looking at the fields. They are really beautiful and I don't want them to go.

Please don't change my home. It would make me really sad and I will cry. Don't build on the fields, because it's not fair!
