Subject – Objection and opposition to proposed housing development in GREENBELT LAND.

SITE HG2-43

This site is in GREENBELT and classified as a nature reserve. The only access for this site – and for the building of 66 houses already approved – is CALVERLEY LANE. A NARROW LANE LEADING ONTO THE A65 APPROX 50 YARDS FROM THE ROUNDABOUT. This exit is also used by most of the residents in the Victorias and Newlathes. This is a very difficult exit and entry lane for all traffic.

SITE HG2-42

This site is in GEENBELT and once again access can only be in and out onto Calverley Lane causing more traffic congestion.

SITE HG2-41

It is difficult to comprehend turning this beautiful area of land into a sprawling building site and finally a town. A huge blot on the landscape. My children and grandchildren have indeed “picked strawberries” there.

There are also many large and magnificent trees which would have to be removed. Once again ALL traffic movement would be onto the A65. Leeds City Council are obsessed with building more and more houses alongside the A65 now one of the most congested roads in and out of Leeds.
