Re: Leeds Site Allocation Plans – Formal Objection

In response to the Leeds Site Allocation Plans, I would put on record my formal objection to the proposed development of the following sites:

HG2-41	(4240)	HG2-42	(1016)
HG2-43	(5009)	HG2-12	(4254)

The open green spaces and fields which are being proposed for development are very important to me. These sites should continue to be part of Leeds 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has sufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).

My concerns include compromising on safety and inability to cope with traffic, education and health, not to mention the affect these developments will have on wildlife.
