Save our Green Belt

I have received a leaflet showing where the various sites for new houses are proposed:

HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon

HG3-2, HG3-4 Fields off A65, Rawdon

HG2-41 Fields South of A65, Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium.

HG2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus.

These include Green Belt sites before brownfield and this is not consistent with the national policy and goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

I do feel that the roads around this area , particularly at rush hours morning and evening are congested enough. The shopping areas in Guiseley and the supermarkets have meant a lot more large wagons on the road in the early morning and evenings and now also at the weekends as the shops are open longer hours.

The new primary schools are already having to extend owing to the shortage of places and I imagine the secondary schools have similar problems. The doctors are already oversubscribed and the waiting time for hospital appointments will no doubt get longer.

In Greenacre Park we are always having problems with lots of cars parking in the road for the various offices around and down to the roundabout on the main road which makes it very dangerous as it cuts out one lane of traffic. As I understand, more yellow lines may be put on the main road this will just make the problem worse on our estate and quite often I have to go on the pavement to get out of my own drive.

I hope that the Green Belts in this area can be preserved for families to go for walks with or without their dogs.
