When our family moved here in 1969, RAWDON was an ideal mix of town and country. Now, if proposals go ahead to build on Green Belt land, it will just become an urban sprawl.

Traffic congestion is already horrendous on the A65. Choose an alternative route to Leeds using Brownburne Lane and you have to negotiate over 20 "sleeping policemen" between the Emott Arms at Rawdon and the Old Ball at Horsforth.

All the following sites -  
HG2-12, HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4,  
HG2-41, and HG2-43 - will  
increase the congestion problem

and has further strain on  
schools, bus services and  
medical needs.

Your proposals to use GREEN  
BELT LAND before brownfield  
sites is not only unacceptable  
but against National Policy.  
Think again and find somewhere  
else. If you go ahead  
with your house building  
proposals, the quality of life  
of hundreds of Rowdon folk  
will seriously deteriorate.  
I like Rowdon as it is.  
Keep it that way.
